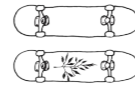

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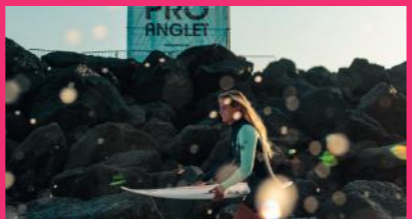

With 4.5km of unspoiled coastline and sandy beaches stretching from the branch of the River Adour at Pointe du Cap St-Martin and a 230 hectare pine forest, Anglet is the perfect playground for those who love wide open spaces and contrasting countryside.

Get your fill of excitement from the variety of leisure and outdoor activities on offer in Anglet: swimming, thalassotherapy, surfing, skateboarding, yoga, golf, cycling, treetop

adventures, beach volleyball, beach rugby, horse riding, basque pelota, and many more. According to walkers and joggers, the coastal walks and countless greenways in the natural areas are the perfect places to go!

THE SURFING 'WALK OF FAME': ANGLET SURF AVENUE

Anglet Surf Avenue, created in 2018, is where you will find the Surfing Walk of Fame in Anglet. The world's biggest names in surfing, including Tom Curren, Justine Dupont, Mick Fanning, and Kai Lenny, have left their footprints in Fabien Cayeré's bronze slabs. Every year new surfing icons will come and receive this honour.



BEACH HOLIDAYS

Every beach here has its own identity and everyone will find their niche! Along the coast you can find a beach club, skate park, beach volleyball courts, yoga, and thalassotherapy. There are coast guards present on several beaches so bathers can have the most fun! With particularly easy access, you can get there on foot, by bike, by bus (there are free beach shuttle buses) and by car (free parking).



SEA, SUN & SURF

Surfing is the 'king' of sports in Anglet! Our 15 surf schools mean that everyone can discover the joys of surfing and improve their technique in total safety. Courses, group lessons, and one-on-one lessons are offered along the Anglet coast from Easter to Halloween. Give it a go and take to the water!



... TO THE FORESTS

'MA E PIGNADA PER M'AIDA' THE SEA AND THE PINE FOREST TO HELP ME

(Motto in Anglet's Gascon language)

The 'green lung' of Anglet is a protected dune forest measuring nearly 220 hectares, populated with maritime pines, cork oaks, brooms, and mimosas. Like all forests, it plays a major ecological role in the area, welcoming a rich biodiversity as well as walkers, joggers, and horse riders.

'IZADIA' ECOLOGICAL PARK

Located at the mouth of the River Adour, this 15 hectare natural space is dedicated to preserving the Atlantic coast's plants and wildlife. You can visit the exhibition and the 1.7km of paths, a stop for migrating birds, from April to October, Tuesdays to Sundays (free entry).

Anglet is a city overflowing with art, hosting a high-quality cultural programme all year round: With exhibitions at the Centre d'Art Contemporain at the Villa Béatrix Enea, Contemporary Art Biennial - La littorale (an exhibition of giant works by international artists on the coast), performances and shows at the Théâtre de Quintaou, open-air film screenings at the International Surf Film Festival or Mociné à la Plage, street art Festival - Les Jours Heureux, and many more.

GOURMET DESTINATION FROM THE MARKET TO THE PLATE
